### **Aqrab Checkpoint**

- 1. 22 person evacuated by our ambulances to the neighboring hospital
- 2. 2650 hot meals distributed to the families
- 3. 2000 ready meals pack distributed
- 4. First aid services provided by 178 person
- 5. Primary psychosocial support to 720 person
- **6.** Dead body management 5 cases

# The Camps

- 1. Producing and distribution of 54000 fresh bread distributed to 5400 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat ,Jada'a and Hamam Al-Alil beside agrab check point
- 2. Our water purification unit produces 2m<sup>3</sup>/h daily and distribute in Madraj camp
- 3. 2350 hot meal distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
- 4. Medical cases 178 cases treated in our clinic in Madraj camp with the Danish RC
- 5. Health team
  - 8 cases from Jada'a camp transferred by ambulance to neighboring hospitals
  - Psychosocial support to 50 children and 40 families
  - Health promotion and personal hygiene to 40 families
  - First aid service 200 person

### The IRCS Erbil with Karbala Branches

- 1. Jama kur camp received 19 new families
- 2. 120.000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
- 3. Distribution of 1000 hot meals with the BCF
- 4. Distribution to the families of Jama Kur 177 cloth boxes with the Turkish RC
- 5. Distribution 372,000Liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
- 6. Total of 596 Medical cases treated as :333 at Qatar RC , 137 at Hasan Shame night shift and 126 cases in the family clinic with Danish RC
- 7. The IRCS health teams place 2 Units for emergency first aid service at the highway between Erbil-Sulaymania the other between Shaqlawa -Erbil to serve the people at Nowruz
