The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.

25th -26th March 2017

The IRCS team continue to support the families of the east bank of Mosul; we support them in the east bank or the displaced families to the west bank, their journey to the camps and inside the camps.

The past two-day's activities as listed below

The IRCS Salahaddin, Thi-Qar and IRCS/HQ

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 79 cases were transferred by the ambulance
2. 11300 hot meals distributed to the families
3. 1150 ready meals pack distributed
4. First aid services provided by 60 person

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60000 fresh bread distributed to 6000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a and Hamam Al-Alil beside aqrab check point
2. Our water purification unit produces 2m³/h daily and distribute in Madraj camp
3. 2450 hot meal distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
4. Medical cases 175 cases treated in our clinic in Madraj camp with the Danish RC
5. Poster, awareness and education for antipersonnel landmines and un-explosive devices were delivered to 600 person
6. Health team
 - Psychosocial support to 600 children and 50 adults
 - Health promotion and personal hygiene to 53 families
 - First aid service 378 person
 - Distribution of 35 first aid bag
 - Distribution of prescribed medication to 165 people

Inside Mousl 1250 families at Hay Al-Intisar received relief pack each pack of one food parcel and 2 water bottle sets

The IRCS Erbil with Karbala Branches

1. Jama Kur camp received 27 new families
2. 120,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
3. Distribution of 2000 hot meals with the BCF
4. Distribution to the families Haweja'a at Debaga 200 cloth boxes with the Turkish RC
5. Distribution 740,000 Liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
6. Total of 1096 Medical cases treated as : 700 at Qatar RC, 250 at Hasan Shame night shift and 146 cases in the family clinic with Danish RC

The IRCS Duhook branch

Inside Mosul

1. Displaced families from the East Bank to the West Bank of Mousl at deserted buildings received from the IRCS 500 Household pack (each pack contain hygiene set, kitchen set, 3 mattresses and 3 blankets) with the German and French RC
2. The health team inside Mousl (During the relief) delivered psychosocial support to 19 children and 30 women.
