We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



Debaga Camps

27th -28th March 2017

Families from Haweja'a had been escaping to the near camps including Debaga and the IRCS teams are supporting them with food and cloth boxes as the Haweja'a liberation operation in the Horizon.

The past two-day's activities as listed below

The IRCS Salahaddin. Thi-Qar and IRCS/HQ

AQRAB checkpoint

1. 68 cases were transferred by the ambulance
2. 12500 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
3. 567 ready meals pack distribution

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60000 fresh bread distributed to 6000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a and Hamam Al-Alil beside aqrab check point
2. Our water purification unit produces 2m³/h daily and distribute in Madraj camp
3. 2350 hot meal with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
4. 3000 families received one water bottle set in Haj Ali camp
5. 331 medical cases treated in our clinic in Madraj camp with the Danish RC
6. Poster, awareness and education for antipersonnel landmines and un-explosive devices were delivered to 358 person
7. Health team
 - Psychosocial support to 608 children and 166 adults
 - Health promotion and personal hygiene to 249 person
 - First aid service 366 person
 - Distribution of 58 first aid bag
 - 2 first aid lectures to 35 individuals
 - Distribution of prescribed medication to 166 people

Inside Mousl 2000 families at Wade Hajar received relief pack each pack of one food parcel and water bottle sets

The IRCS Erbil Branch

1. 120.000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
2. Distribution of 2000 hot meals with the BCF
3. Distribution to the families Haweja'a at Debaga 1300 food baskets
4. Distribution 330 cloth boxes with blankets at Debaga camp with the Turkish RC
5. Distribution 740,000 Liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
6. Total of 942 Medical cases treated as :593at Qatar RC, 209 at Hasan Shame night shift and 140 cases in the family clinic with Danish RC
