The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



New camps

29th -30th March 2017

Jada'a 5 and Nerkizlee 2 camps with in the past few days received 1048 and 2000 displaced families respectively. The IDPs are from west of Mosul

The IRCS support and congratulate new family celebrating their wedding in Hamam Al-Alil camp!

The past two-day's activities as listed below

The IRCS Salahaddin, Thi-Qar and IRCS/HQ

AQRAB checkpoint and Hamam Al-Alil check point

1. 110 cases were transferred by the ambulance
2. 16000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families at Aqrab check point
3. 5200 ready meal packs distribution at Aqrab check point
4. 1000 ready meal packs distributed at Hamam Al-Alil check point

The Camps

1. Distribution of 60,000 fresh bread distributed to 6000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a and Hamam Al-Alil beside check points
2. Our water purification unit produces 2m³/h daily and distribute in Madraj camp
3. 2450 hot meal with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
4. 950 families received one food basket with kitchen set in Haj Ali camp
5. 300 families in Madraj camp received cloth boxes with Turkish RC
6. 140 ready meals pack distributed at Madraj camp
7. 328 medical cases treated in our clinic in Madraj camp with the Danish RC
8. Health team
 - Psychosocial support to 150 children and 1819 adults
 - Health promotion and personal hygiene to 61 person
 - First aid service 155 person
 - Distribution of 20 first aid bag
 - first aid lecture to 12 individual

The IRCS Erbil Branch

1. 120,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
2. Distribution of 3000 hot meals with the BCF
3. Distribution 690,000 Liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
4. Distribution of 120 cloth box for the families of Jama Kur with the Turkish RC
5. Total of 990 Medical cases treated as :600 at Qatar RC, 165 at Hasan Shame night shift and 225 cases in the family clinic with Danish RC

The IRCS Duhook Branch

Inside Mosul

500 families received relief pack inside Mosul (divided between resident of Hay Al-Zuhoor and Hadba'a) each relief pack contain one food basket, one hygiene set, 2 mattresses and 3 blankets

Health team delivered first aid service to one person, psychosocial support to 15 children and 22 women

The camp

The IRCS team delivered to 444 families inside Nerkizlee 2 camp food pack each pack consist of food parcel and 35Kg Rice bag with the ICRC
