## MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



### MOSUL

5<sup>th</sup> -6<sup>th</sup> April 2017

The IRCS health teams provided Mosul from 3 zones with different services beside IDP families in deserted building inside Tikrit.

**Mosul** approached in the past 48 hours as following-

1. Providing hospitals with 250 food baskets (Al-Khansa'a, Al-Shefa'a, Ibn Al-Atheer, Qayara and Muharebeen health teams)
2. 500 families in Hay Al-Intisar received package with French RC (each package contain food basket, hygiene and kitchen set)
3. 500 families received relief pack at Hay Al-Zahra 'a. Each relief pack contain kitchen set, hygiene set, two mattresses and three blankets with the French RC and German RC
4. 2500 water bottle of 17 liters were delivered to 500 families in Hay Al-Falah and Hay Al-Sakkar with the French RC
5. Health team delivered psychosocial support to 22 women and 50 children
6. **Inside Tikrit** ERWA program to 400 beneficiaries beside 3 first aid lectures to 22 residence of Haykel areas

The past two-day's other activities as listed below:-

#### The IRCS Salahaddin, Qadyssia and Najaf branches

##### AQRAB checkpoint

1. 57 cases were transferred by the ambulance
2. 4550 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
3. 300 ready meals pack distribution

##### The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60000 fresh bread distributed to 6000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a and Hamam Al-Alil beside aqrab check point
2. Our water purification unit produces 2m<sup>3</sup>/h daily and distribute in Madraj camp
3. 5500 hot meal with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
4. 550 families received one food basket in both camps Madraj and Hamam Al-Alil camp
5. 250 medical cases treated in our clinic in Madraj camp with the Danish RC
6. Health team delivered
  - First aid services 335 patient
  - 36 first aid bag distributed inside Jada'a camp
  - Different Psychosocial support to 1664 person

#### The IRCS Erbil, Mosul and Muthana Branches

1. 30.000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
2. Distribution of 2000 hot meals with the BCF
3. 1428 Families received food basket and 35 Kg rice in Jama Kur with ICRC
4. Distribution 566,000 Liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
5. Total of 778 Medical cases treated as :440 at Qatar RC, 182 at Hasan Shame night shift and 156 cases in the family clinic with Danish RC
6. Health team activities :
  - Psychosocial support to 715 children, 20 tent visits and 233 adults
  - 4 First aid lecture to 135 person
  - Health promotion and personal hygiene with poster and flyers to 700 person

#### The IRCS Duhook Branch

1. 433 families received food baskets in Nerkizlee camp
2. 1081 Syrian families in Qwelan camp received hygiene sets with German RC
3. Keperito 1 camp in Sinjar had health team activities of:
  - Health promotion and personal hygiene to 35 person
  - 5 First aid lectures to 50 person beside providing them with first aid bags
