We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



IRCS Health teams

11th -12th April 2017

The IRCS health team contribution to the IDP camps and to vulnerable inside cities through different programs help to improve the wellbeing of different age people in those locations.

Yesterday there has been fire in Khazer camp with no human causality.

The past two-day's activities as listed below: -

The IRCS Salahaddin, Missan, Basra branches and IRCS/HQ

AQRAB checkpoint

1. 14 cases were transferred by the ambulance
2. 9500 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
3. 400 ready meals pack distribution

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60000 fresh bread distributed to 6000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a and Hamam Al-Alil beside Aqrab checkpoint
2. Our water purification unit produces 2m³/h daily and distribute in Madraj camp
3. 14500 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
4. 500 families in Jada'a 5 and Madraj received relief pack (one food basket, kitchen set, hygiene set and dozen water bottle sets)
5. 260 medical cases treated in our clinic in Madraj camp with the Danish RC

The IRCS Erbil branch

The camps

1. 60.000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
2. Distribution of 1000 hot meals with the BCF
3. Distribution 712,000 Liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
4. Total of 536 Medical cases treated as :352 at Qatar RC and 184 at Hasan Shame night shift
5. Health team activities:
 - Psychosocial support to 84 children, 136 tent visits and 184 adults
 - 9 First aid lecture to 249 person and distribution of 30 First aid bags
 - Health promotion and personal hygiene with poster and flyers to 75 person

Inside Mosul distribution of 250 family parcels with French RC at Hay Nabee Younis and Hay Al-Ta'amem

The IRCS Duhok and Mosul Branches

1. 459 food basket and 35Kg rice were distributed in Qaymawa camp with ICRC
2. The health team inside camps
 - Nerkizlee camp 1 and psychosocial support to 200 women and 50 children
 - Qaymawa camp psychosocial support to 25 children
 - Khanaky camp health activities
 - I. 5 First aid lectures with distribution of first aid bag to 50 people and 200 adults
 - II. Health promotion and personal hygiene 54 person
 - III. Psychosocial support 15 tents visit
 - Kerbtto camp 1
 - 5 first aid lecture with first aid bag distribution to 50 person
 - Psychosocial support visit to 10 families in bakhmate village
 - Psychosocial support to 15 women escaped Daish
