

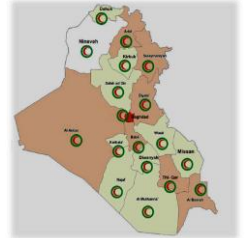

MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



The International Humanitarian Law IHL

Educating the people with the international humanitarian laws and the fundamental principles of the Red Cross Red Crescent movements is a major task built in the Red Cross and Red Crescent component and IRCS embrace all the opportunities to spread humanitarian laws and treaties between different age groups.

The past few day's activities as listed below:-

The IRCS Salahaddin Branch

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 8500 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 150 ready meals pack distribution

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 90,000 fresh bread distributed to 9000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a and Hamam Al-Alil beside Aqrab check point
2. Our water purification unit produces 2m³/h daily and distribute in Madraj camp
3. 26,800 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp

Inside Mosul

1000 families in Door Al-Sawass and Al-Dandan received relief pack (one food basket and 2 water bottle dozen sets)

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. 90,000 fresh bread distributed in the camps
2. Distribution 243,000 Liter of potable water from M40 unit to the camps
3. Total of 915 Medical cases treated as :588 at Qatar RC and 327 at Hasan Shame night shift
4. Health team activities inside camps
 - Different Psychosocial support to 210 person
 - 6 First aid lecture to 167 person
 - Health promotion and personal hygiene with poster and flyers to 108 person

Inside Mosul 500 Families in Hay Al-Meethaq received family pack (each pack of 3 blankets, 2 mattresses, hygiene set and kitchen set) with French and German RC

The IRCS Duhok Branch

Inside Mosul

- 500 families of Hay Al-Noor received water bottle set (each set of 5 bottle of 17liter /bottle) with French RC
- The health team provided Psychosocial support to 30 adult and 20 children in same neighborhood

Inside camps

1. Qaymawa camp Distribution of 10 food parcel (each parcel of one food basket and 35Kg rice) with ICRC
2. Nerkizlee camp distribution of 119 food parcel to 115 families (each parcel of one food basket and 35Kg rice) with ICRC
3. Sharia camp health team delivered to high school girls workshop on international humanitarian law
