**May 8<sup>th</sup>**, is an annual celebration of the principles of the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement. (World Red Cross Red Crescent Day). This date is the anniversary of the birth of Henry Dunant (born 8 May 1828), the founder of International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) and the recipient of the first Nobel Peace Prize.

**The past two-day's activities as listed below:-**

### **The IRCS Salahaddin, Babel Branches and IRCS/HQ**

#### • **Aqrah Checkpoint**

1. 12,400 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 227 ready meals pack distribution

#### • **Mesheryafa 2 Checkpoint**

1750 families inside Mesheryafa 2 check point received ready meal pack (each pack contain ready meals, bread and one water bottle dozen set)

#### • **Hamam Al Alil Checkpoint**

1. 9,200 hot meals with water bottles distributed
2. 150 ready meal pack delivered

### **The Camps**

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 fresh bread distributed to 6000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a and the checkpoints
2. Our water purification unit produces 2m<sup>3</sup>/h daily and distribute in Madraj camp
3. 850 families in the Hamam Al-Alil 2 camp received relief pack (each pack contain food basket with 35Kg rice and 3 blankets) with ICRC

### **The IRCS Erbil Branch**

#### **Inside camps**

1. Distribution of 780,000 liter of potable water from M40 Unit inside camp
2. Production and distribution of 60,000 bread inside the camp

**Inside Mosul** 250 families in Hay Al-Mithaq received family pack with the French RC

### **The IRCS Duhok Branch**

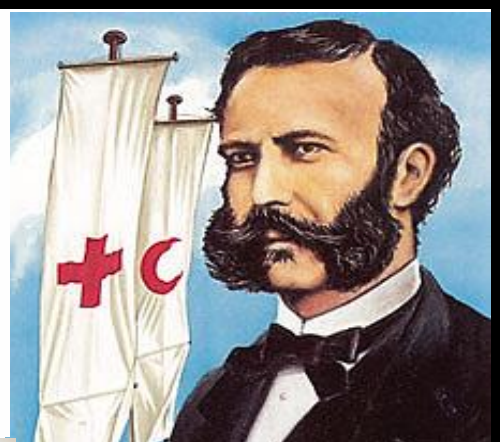
#### **Camps**

1. Qwelan camp 531 families received 615 hygiene set with German RC
2. Qaymawa camp health team delivered health promotion and personal hygiene to 48 person

#### **Inside Mosul**

1. 500 families in Hay Al-Arygeia received relief pack each pack contain food basket, 5Kg Rice and 5 water bottles each of 17 liter /bottle) with the French RC
2. Distribution of flyer about Education and awareness for Mosul dam collapse hazard to 400 person
3. Distribution to 300-person mostly primary school students and teachers clothes, shoes and toys with American charity organization
4. Psychosocial support to 50 children and 45 women
