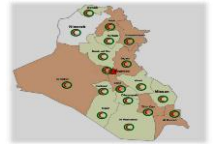




The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY MOSUL LIBERATION OPERATION BULLETIN

(IRCS) Bulletin issue..(92) 15th May 2017 Monday **with photo annex**

The Iraqi Red Crescent Society (IRCS) is an Independent, volunteer-based National Society that works to alleviate suffering for all and referee the international humanitarian laws and treaties ratified by the Iraqi government. We are also an auxiliary body to government when responding to humanitarian needs including the Mosul liberation operation beside our heading and membership of different committees inside Iraq that involved in the humanitarian response. However, we maintain our independence from authorities and function as an autonomous, apolitical, non-partisan organization. Our interventions alleviate the suffering in accordance with the movement's fundamental principles since 1932.



Water trucking in Mosul

13th-14th May 2017

Shortage of potable water inside Mosul is another humanitarian crisis, the IRCS team with the French RC installed 20 tanks inside Mosul district each tank of 5m³ size and water trucks will fill them from Mosul water purification establishment to allow better access to clean water

The past two-day's activities as listed below:-

The IRCS Salahaddin Branch

Aqrab Checkpoint

1. 22,000 hot meals with water bottles distributed to the families
2. 140 ready meals pack distribution

Mesheryafa 2 checkpoint

- 175 ready meals packs distributed to the families

Hamam al-Alil checkpoint

1. 11,300 hot meals with water bottles distributed in Hamam Al-Alil camp
2. 700 ready meal pack in Hamam Al-Alil camp

The Camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 fresh bread distributed to 6000 families at Madraj, Tel-Sebat, Jada'a, Hamam Al-Alil and the checkpoints
2. Our water purification unit produces 1m³/h daily and distribute in Madraj camp

EAS

IRCS team transferred seven medical cases with the Norwegian RC

- One cases from Jada'a camp to Qayara hospital
- To MSF hospital : One case from Badosh, 2 from Hay Al-Resalla and 3 from Wade Al-Ayen

The IRCS Erbil Branch

Inside camps

1. Producing and distribution of 60,000 bread inside camps
2. 3500 hot meals produced and distributed with BCF
3. Producing and distribution of 725,000 liter of water from M40 Unit inside the camps
4. 550 ready meal pack distributed to new arrival of Jama Kur U2
5. 385 families in Jama Kur U2 received relief pack (food basket, 35Kg rice, kitchen set, hygiene set, stove, thermos, 2 Jerri cans, 2 towels, tarpaulin and 6 blankets) with ICRC
6. 718 Medial cases treated: 542 medical cases in Khazer with Qatar RC and 176 cases at night shift in Hasan shame
7. Detecting and informing to medical authorities about 1000 cases of scabies and other skin diseases among camps
8. Psychosocial support to 258 children in open day and 26 tent visit
9. Health promotion and personal hygiene 247 person
10. 6 first aid workshops and distribution of first aid bag to 45 person

Inside Mosul

1. 400 families inside Hay Al-Qadyssia and Hay Al-Rashedyia received relief pack (each pack with food basket and cloth box and blankets) with the Turkish RC
2. Distribution of 200,000 liter of potable water to tanks inside districts
