RMS is a web-based, GIS-enabled system that supports National Societies' and IFRC's program management activities. It helps National Societies to manage their human and material resources and view this information on map together with various demographic and vulnerability related overlays. It also allows them to collect and analyses field assessments, track key information of programs and projects in addition to communities' vulnerability and resilience levels.

RMS has been developed in conformity with the Declaration of 7th Asia Pacific Conference in Singapore 2006, which "called on all National Societies to develop and use a disaster management resource mapping database at national and regional levels based on guidelines established by the Federation."As a result of successful piloting and implementation in National Societies of the Asia Pacific zone, it is now available as a tool for all National Societies around the world, and accordingly, the Iraq RC is signed the agreement to install and use this software.
