

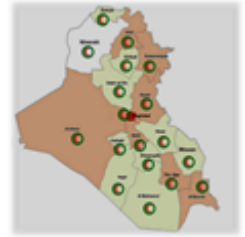


# The IRAQI RED CRESCENT SOCIETY

### The IRCS Sulymania Branch

Despite many families are returning back to their homes in Kirkuk and surrounding areas, the IRCS continue to provide the remaining families with different services as following :-

1. The health team visit Saradash camp and delivered psychosocial support through 13 tent visits and open day to 73 children
2. Distribution 250 water bottle dozen sets to families in Saradash camp
3. 200 families in Bazyann subdistrict received relief pack (each pack contain food basket ,35Kg rice ,kitchen set , hygien set ,thermos , stove ,kettle ,tarpaulin , 2 jerricans ,2 towels and 6 blankets ) with the ICRC
