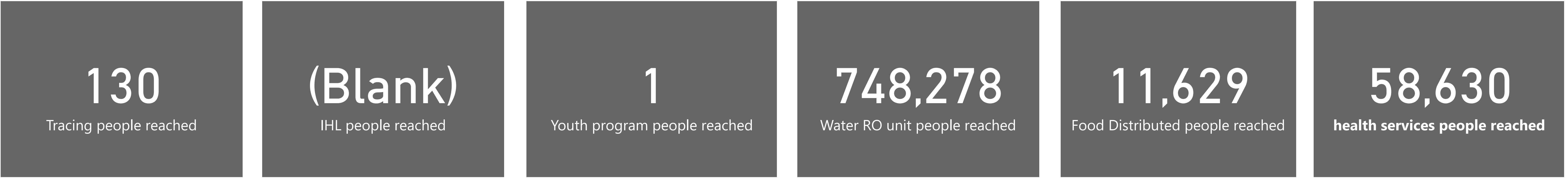




## Background

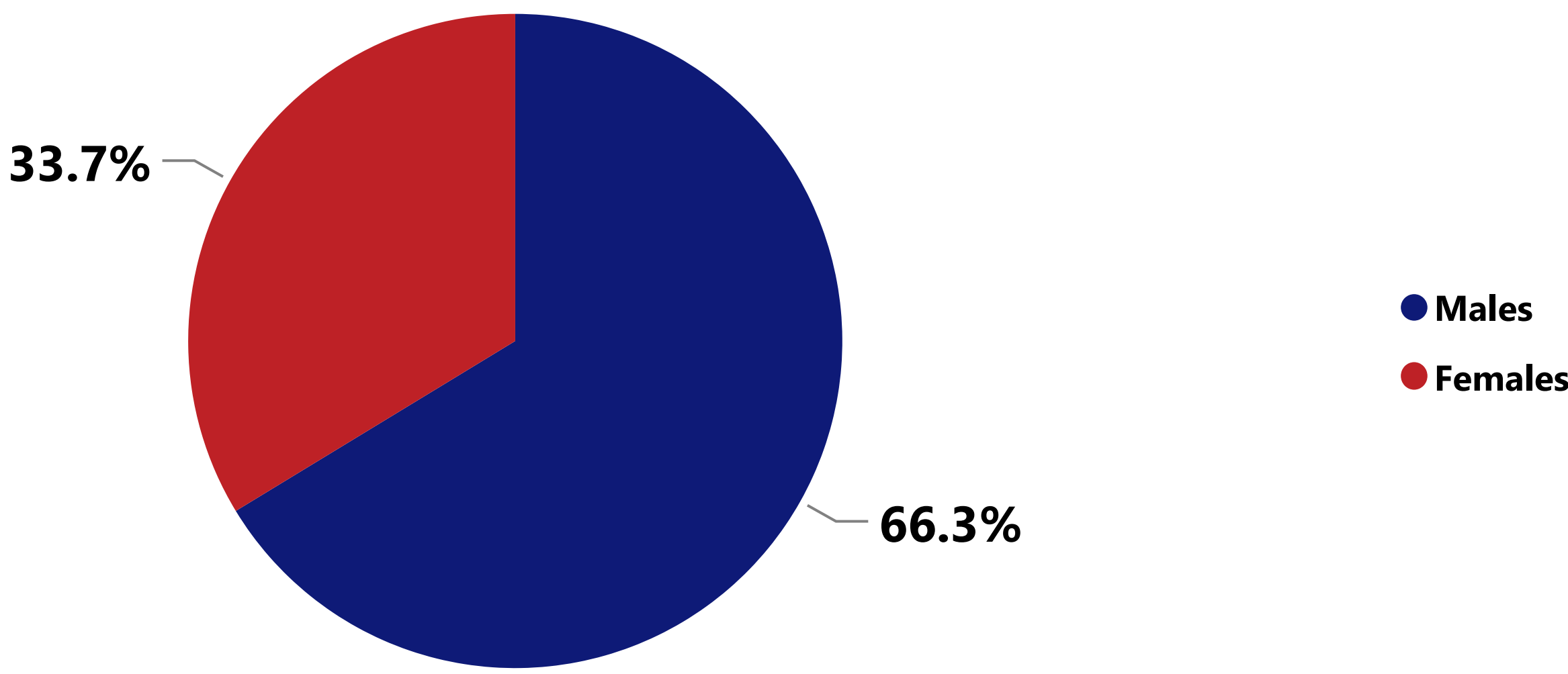

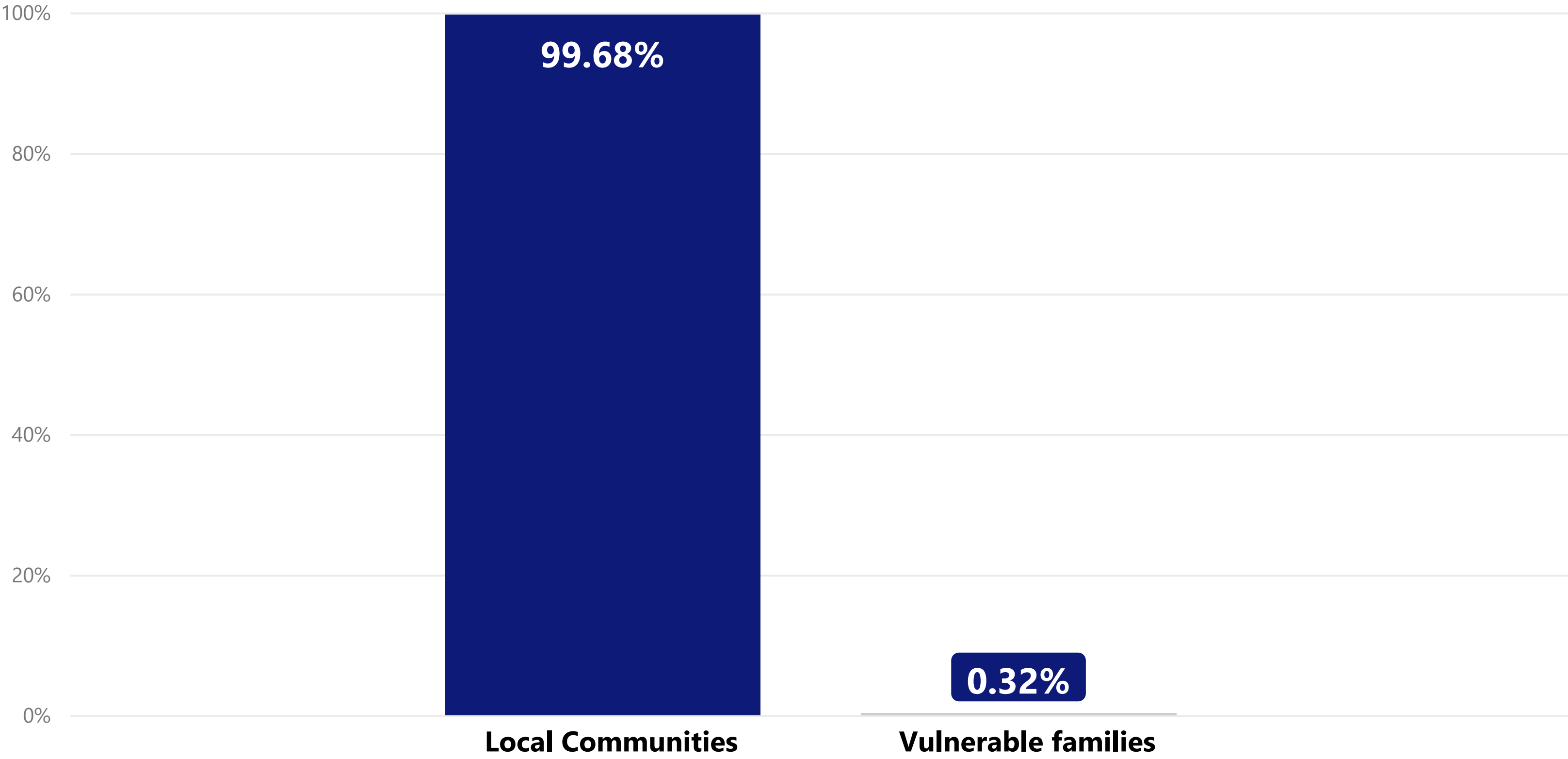

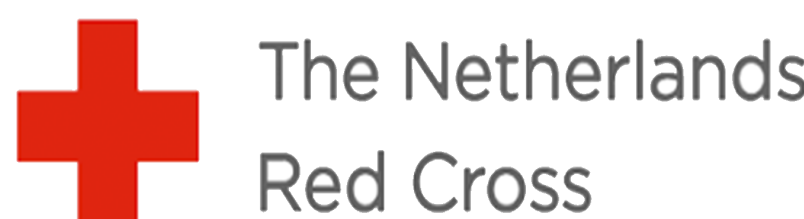
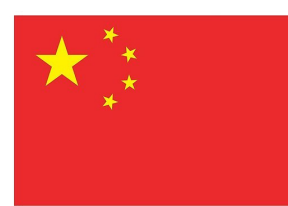
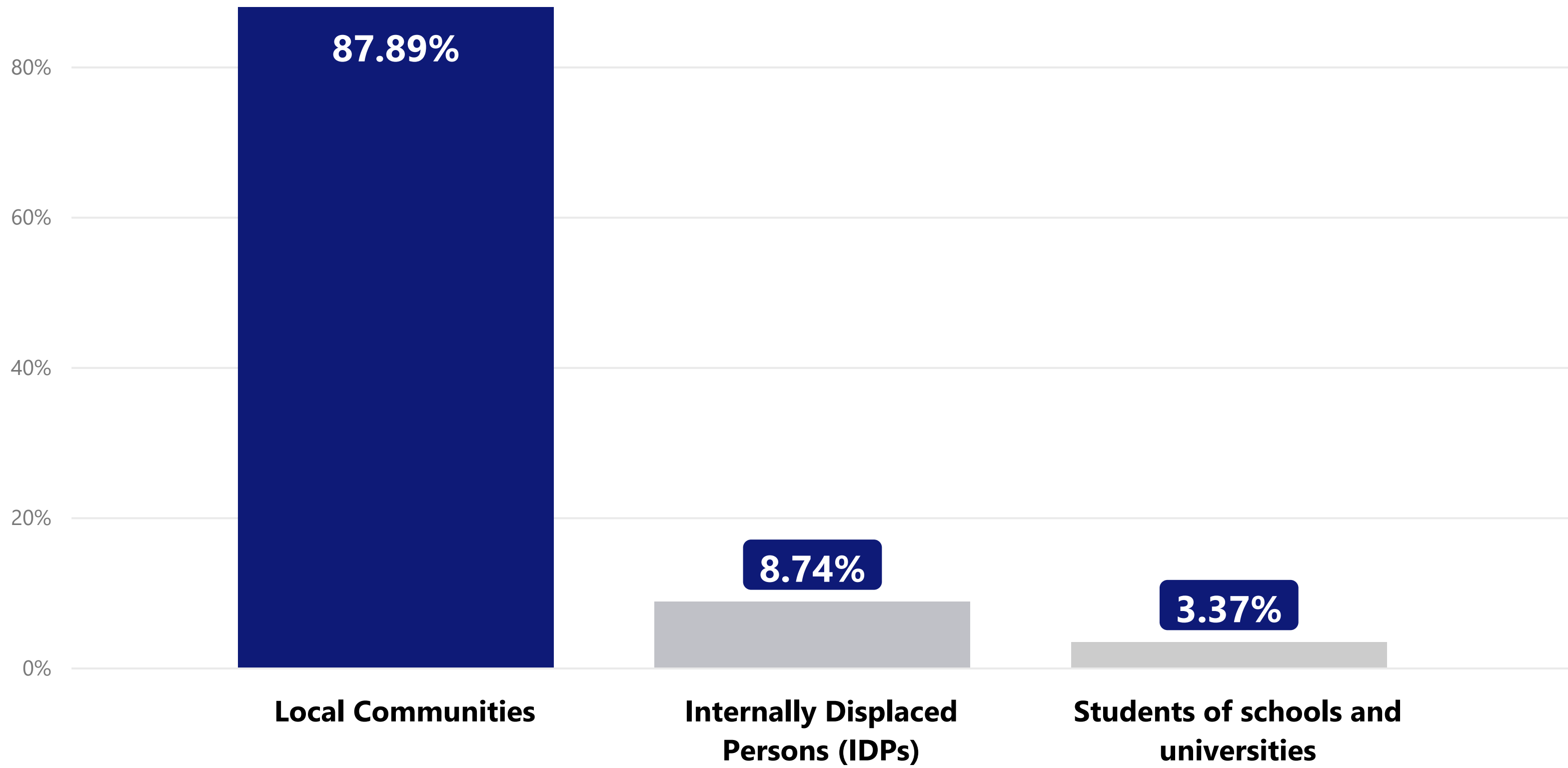
### Percentage of Beneficiaries/Gender

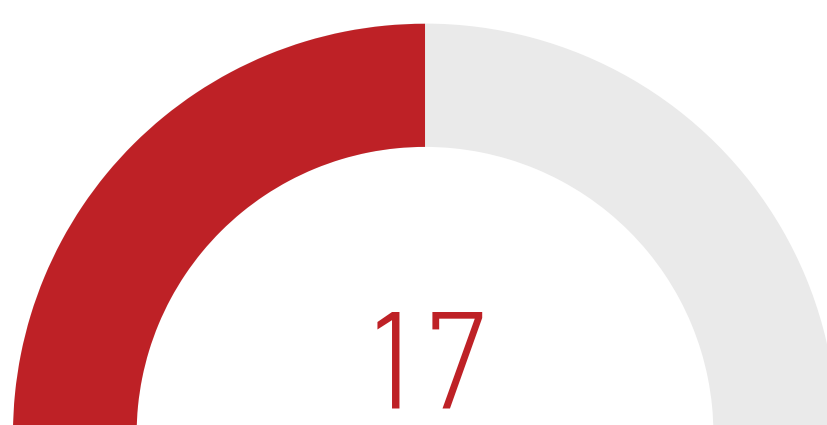

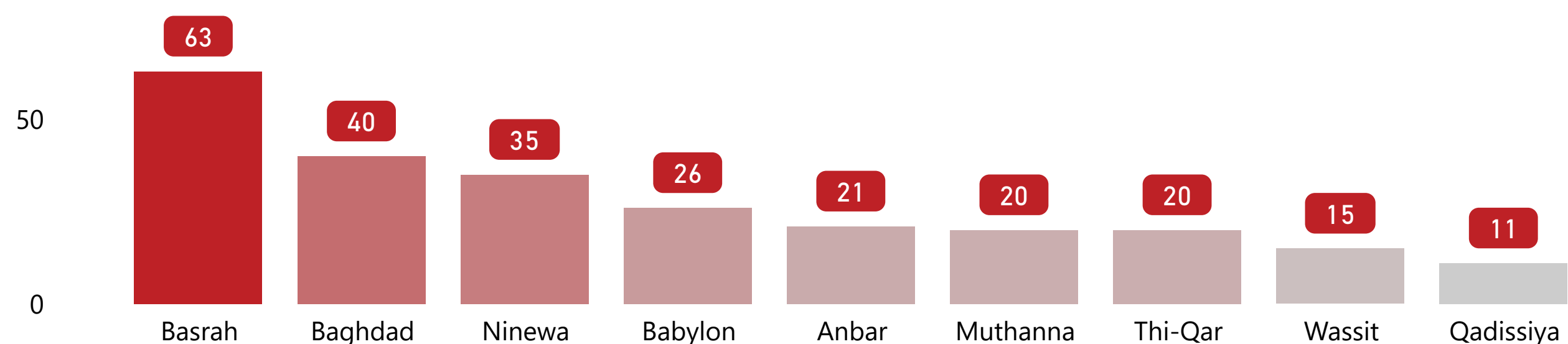
