Distributed in Fallujah and Mosul camps.

Distributed across all governorates.

Key items: **402** tons of flour • **56,892** rice bags (35 kg) • **700** lentil bags (5 kg) • **29,437** ice molds • Child nutrition: **5,000** meals, **1,056** milk cartons, **4,695** additional milk cans

- \$157,200 to 786 families in Duhok
- \$670,000 to 670 families in Erbil

- \$257,000 distributed in remote areas



Other support: 5,249 families supported in Duhok with IQD 2,885,025,000 • 3,399 families supported in Erbil with €679,800 and 655 families with \$131,000 • Building materials provided to 1,159 Syrian refugee families

Produced by 14 reverse osmosis (RO) plants in Baghdad, Babil, Wasit and Erbil.

95,819,200 L

Delivered by 85 tanks in Nineveh, plus 25,000 bottles of 17 liters.


Health Services (2014–2017)

Protection & Restoring Family Links



Evacuations

- 46 foreign nurses evacuated from Tikrit Hospital (plus 4 each from Al-Qaim, Ana and Haditha).
- 1 foreign anesthetist evacuated to the Jordan–Iraq border.
- 63 workers evacuated from Fallujah Hospital; 38 facilitated to depart Iraq.

Missing persons & family links

- 34,000 people benefited from tracing services (family certificates, Red Cross messages, tracing requests).
- Evacuated nurses received meals and \$10 phone cards to stay in touch with their families.
